

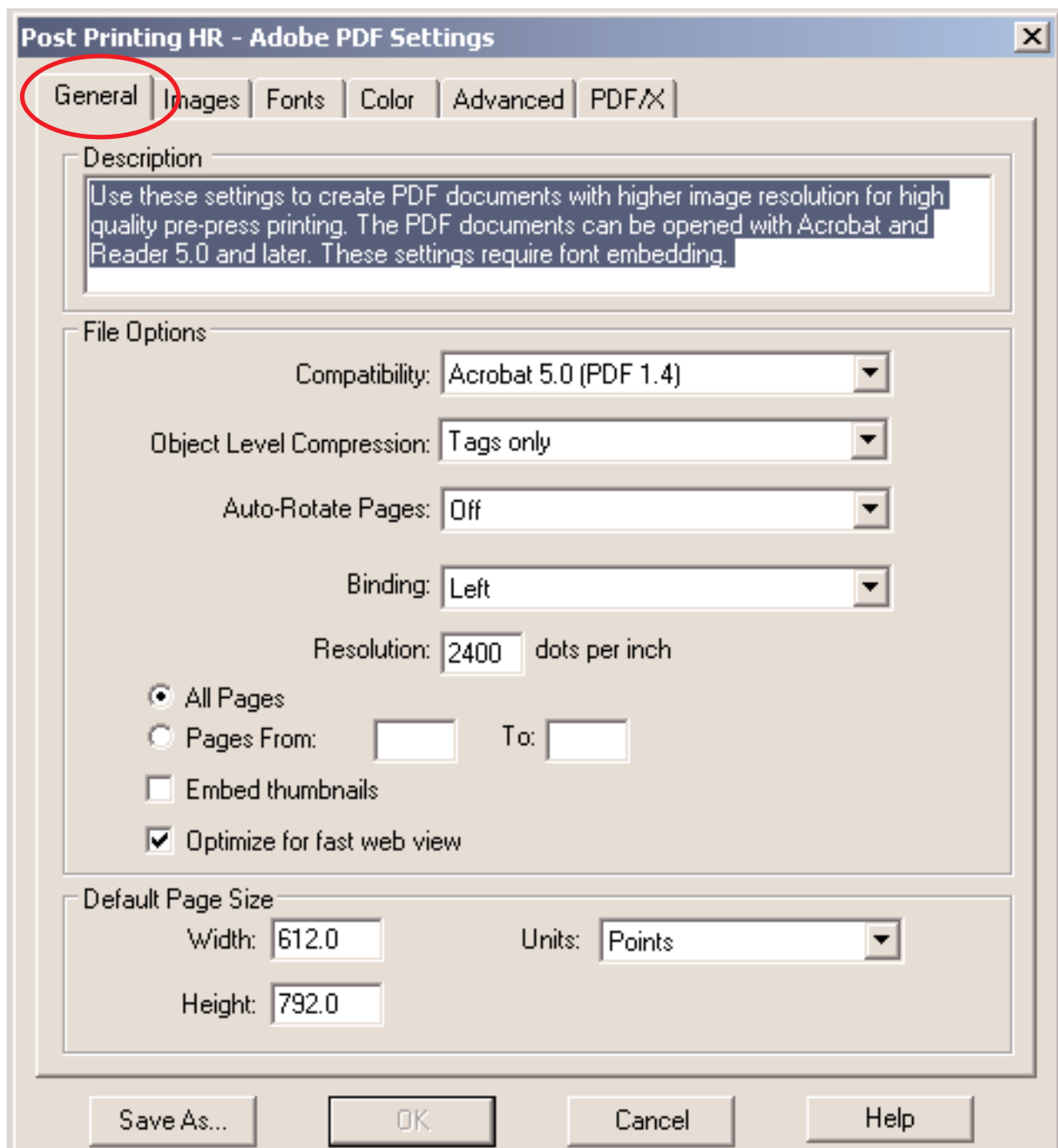

1. Launch Distiller and open the settings

for images above: 1800 pixels per inch

Compression: CCITT Group 4

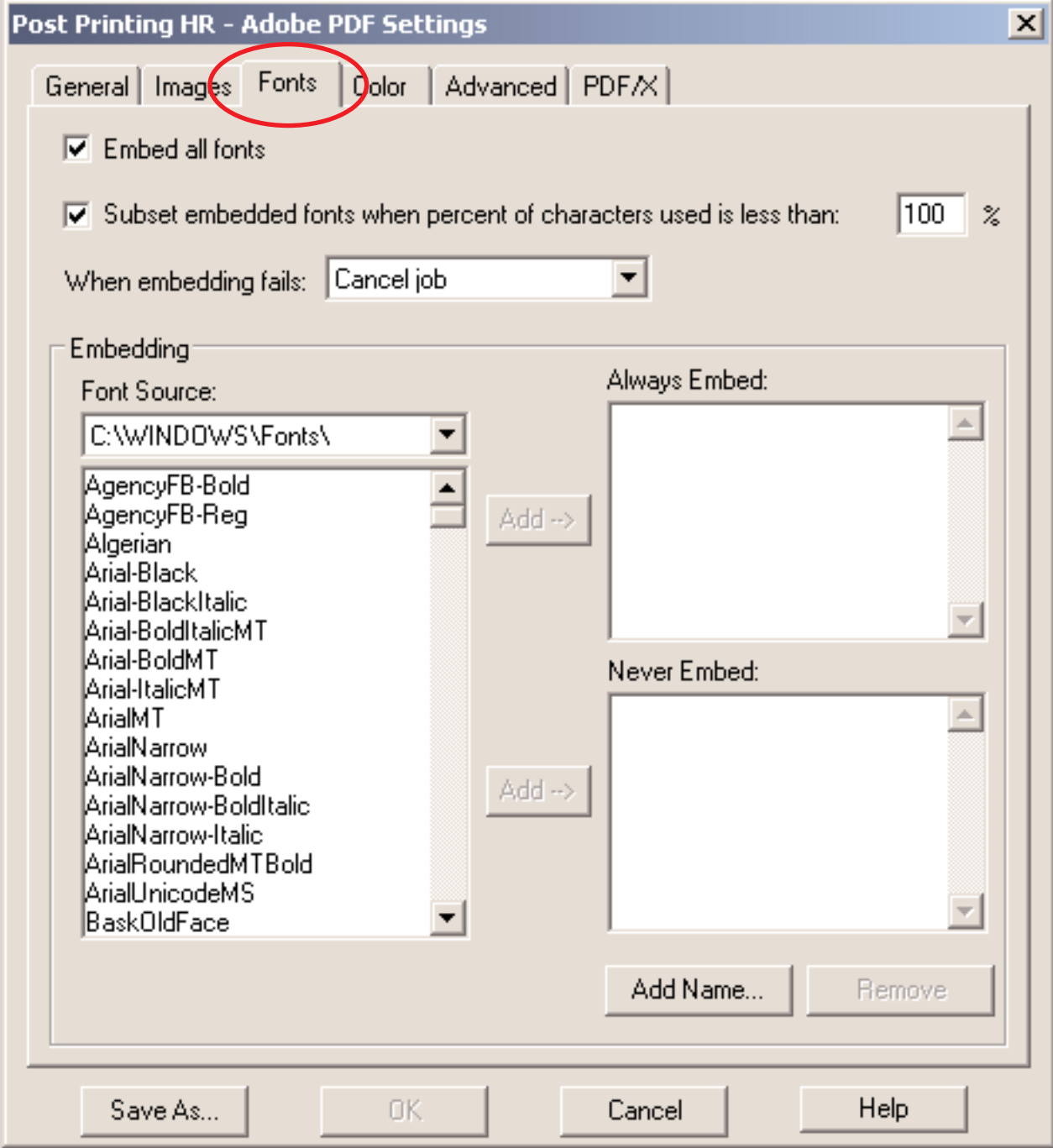
